Easier Show Dollars Management

- You now have three (3) options on how to issue Show Dollars (\$ amount by item or bundle and/or a top up option at the end of the transaction)
- Show Dollars inventory is not required
- Show Dollars are no longer required to be uploaded to vendor accounts
- As you spend, your account will accumulate the total spend
- You only pay for the total spent

Data Reporting

• All transactions are recorded with reports available online, allowing you to reconcile daily

Ease of transactions

- All transactions are instantly credited to the customer's account and debited to the vendor
- Added security you will be asked to verify once amount is entered to ensure accuracy

Instant flexibility

 Instantly reward your best customers with custom Show Dollars amounts – amounts distributed are up to each vendor and are decided on a transactional basis
