TRAVELING AROUND LAS VEGAS

Shuttle Bus Service: By booking your hotel through our official vendor, OnPeak, you receive complimentary shuttle bus service to and from all hotels on our official housing block (excluding the LVH, and Four Seasons Las Vegas). Bus passes can be purchased for an additional \$30.

Airport Shuttle: The most economical way to get to your hotel. Shuttles can cost less than \$10 for a ride to the Strip/Downtown. Check with your hotel for schedules. You can purchase a shuttle pass after you have received your luggage at the airport, outside of the baggage claim.

Car Rentals: The average price for an economy car in Vegas is around \$25 to \$30 per day, but the sky's the limit if you want a little more extravagant.

Limousine Services: See Las Vegas in style for as low as \$35 an hour. Options and pricing vary depending on the vehicle and services.

Parking: Free parking is abundant. Virtually every major hotel offers free valet parking (don't forget to tip!)

Taxis: Fares start with \$3.30 on the meter, and \$2.65 is then added for every additional mile.

The Las Vegas Monorail: The Monorail travels from Sahara Ave to the MGM Grand 7 days per week from 7 a.m.-2 a.m. Monday-Thursday and until 3 a.m. Friday-Sunday. Visit website for location stops and ticket prices. www.lvmonorail.com

Vegas on Foot: You will still cover a lot of the city on foot. Be sure to wear comfortable shoes and carry a bottle of water, especially during summer months.
