



## **BOOTH CONSTRUCTION REGULATIONS & DIAGRAMS**

### **ISLAND BOOTH**

**ISLAND BOOTH:** A minimum of four standard booths with aisles surrounding all four sides of the exhibit.

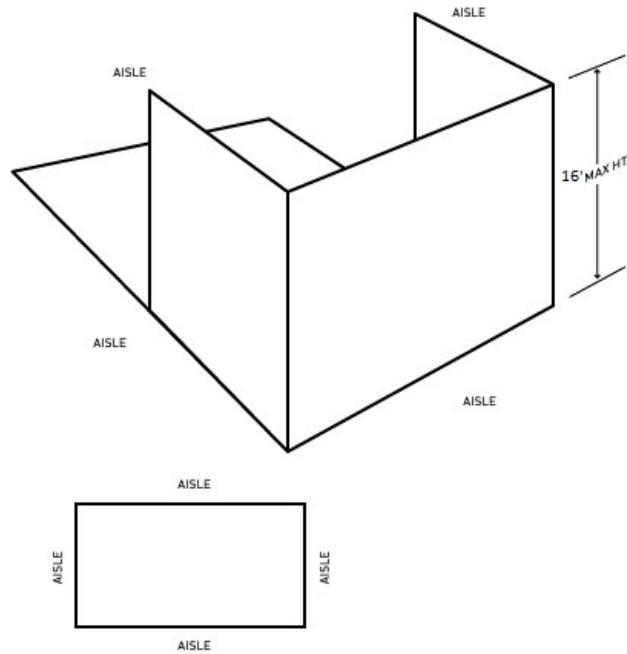
- The maximum height is 16', (higher with Show Management approval.) Request to exceed 16' must be submitted to Beth Engle by March 20, 2023 at [beth.engle@informa.com](mailto:beth.engle@informa.com).
- If you have a hanging sign, there must be at least 3' clearance from the top of the booth to the bottom of the sign and the total booth presence cannot exceed 20'. Hanging sign must be 10' from the adjacent booth. The width of any hanging or attached signs should not exceed 50% of the booth width.
- If you have any type of interactive display, you must have a 3-foot clearance from the aisle(s) to allow for crowds.
- Walls may be installed in any portion of the booth; however, 50 percent of the perimeter of the booth must be left open. Walls must be finished on both sides so as not to be unsightly to neighboring exhibitors.
- Please bring all US Engineer-stamped, approved plans on-site for the Fire Marshal. The Fire Marshal reserves the right to deny booth construction without these plans.

**\*\*Booths with structures 12 feet or taller must submit an engineer stamped booth drawing plan.\*\***

**\*\*Booths 10' x 20' or larger are required to submit a Booth Rendering. See Booth Rules & Regulations for details.\*\***
