EXHIBITOR INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

*NEW

For the \$300 Exhibitor Insurance Program (EIP) Participation Fee you receive:

1. Sufficient general liability insurance coverage: \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate.
2. Plus: Up to \$40,000 in coverage towards cancellation expenses and exhibitor property.

How does the EIP work?

1. Exhibitors will see the \$300 Insurance Participation Fee included in their Event contract and invoice.
2. Once contracted, the Exhibitor will receive an e-mail from InEvexco with details of the policy and instructions to upload proof of their own insurance documents if they do not wish to participate in Informa's policy.
3. Exhibitors can:
 - a. Choose to upload their own insurance documents to be credited the \$300 fee OR
 - b. Pay the \$300

If you elect to obtain your own insurance:

Required Coverage:

As an exhibitor, you are required to carry commercial general liability insurance including products and completed operations, contractor's personal injury and blanket contractual liability insurance at limits of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate. Coverage should begin from the first move-in day (**February 8, 2025**) and last through the last move-out day (**February 13, 2025**) and name Las Vegas Convention Center, Informa plc, MAGIC, PROJECT, SOURCING at MAGIC.

How to purchase insurance:

Contact your insurance provider to add the additional insureds as noted in the Required Coverage paragraph above. Purchase your insurance using the same name you gave us on your exhibit space contract as the "exhibiting company." If that name is different from your corporate name, then please list it as a DBA (doing business as).
