How to donate:

Large booth items

Venue staff will distribute information on how to donate large items for recycling

Small booth items

Take smaller items to donation bins around the show floor

Badges

On your last day at the show place your badges in the badge back bins by the exit

What to donate: Pens, notepads & office equipment Booth graphics Promotional & giveaway items Bottled water Cut flowers in

Reduces shipping costs AND carbon emissions from transportation

Before

Promotional materials

Consider digital options over printed materials

Don't bring more brochures than you need!



Printing tips

Print on post-consumer recycled paper using vegetable based inks

Make all printed materials timeless (not date specific) so they can be reused

Print locally - <u>Click</u> to find printers in Las Vegas

Packing

Avoid using styrofoam packing peanuts, these are not recyclable


During Move-in



Flatten & stack cardboard boxes on your booth for collection



Pack all plastic wrap & Visqueen in a pile at the corner of your booth



Use non-reinforced Visqueen to protect your booth carpet as this is recyclable -Nylon-reinforced Visqueen is not recyclable

Sustainable Logistics

Shipping

Leave excess items at home
Use recyclable packaging

Ship items by sea/rail

Landfill Materials

AVOID USING

Foamcore

Made from polystyrene, it's dirty to manufacture & CAN'T be recycled in Las Vegas

Vinyl (PVC)

Vinyl is toxic and CANNOT be recycled in Las Vegas (example: Komatex)

Recycable Materials

USE

Falconboard

Reusable, renewable and 100% recyclable rigid material made from honeycombed cardboard. This is what IMEX uses for all rigid signage

conVerd Board

A fiber-based, rigid, recyclable material
