

	Work Full-Time Exhibitors Can Do*
I&D Work	Use full-time employees to set-up booth: can use tools; no time limit
Material Handling	Hand carry from a privately-owned vehicle (POV); Use a personal luggage/office supply dolly; (the use of hand carts is prohibited)
Ground Supported Truss	Exhibitor (or EAC) can assemble ground-supported truss that is booth structure
Signs	Install and dismantle a non-electric sign that is attached to a display. Installing hanging signs is prohibited
Electrical	Plug into any receptacle up to 20A/120VAC; Hang up to four small clip-on lights per 10'x10'
Cleaning	Clean their own booth (EACs may not vacuum or use floor cleaning equipment)
Internet and Cables	Plug/Unplug phones, modems, credit card machines; Run cabling within their structure's walls
	* must be able to prove employment with pay stub or company medical ID

Official Contractor Jurisdiction
I&D labor not handled by full-time exhibitors or EACs
Manages freight docks, unloads trucks, moves all freight, moves in display vehicles
GES is exclusive provider of rigging
Rigging for all ceiling-hung signs and truss
GES provides all electrical distribution; runs cables under carpet, connects power in excess of 20A/120V
GES is exclusive provider including vacuuming, trash removal, carpet cleaning
Cox is exclusive in-house contractor providing all under-floor non-electrical wiring (Ethernet, HDMI) and run any cables to the roof
