

## **ATTENTION 2019 NATIA EXHIBITORS**


- Exhibitor's displays must comply with all requirements of NATIA as well as the building rules and regulations. This is inclusive of maximum height requirements. NATIA has adopted the International Association of Exhibitions and Events (IEEE) "2011 Guidelines for Display Rules and Regulations" regarding booth spaces.
- Height Restrictions: Inline booths: 8' Island booths: 16'
- NO FULLY ENCLOSED SPACES, i.e. meeting rooms, conference rooms or separate occupy able spaces are permitted. If your booth contains a separate space, such as a seating/meeting area, etc. it must have full open and unimpeded view to/from the aisle of the show floor with a 5' or larger opening. Hanging signs for 2019 NATIA will be allowed. Please see the hanging sign rules and regs in the exhibitor services manual. One modification to these rules is as follows:

Inline exhibits WILL BE permitted to have a hanging sign. The guidelines for inline sign hangs are:

- 1. The sign may not extend past your booth line on any side
- 2. Signs must not advertise over your neighbors' booth. As an example:



The orange shows a banner in Booth 101, the arrow indicates the direction of the sign copy. The back side of this banner (which would be visible over Booth 200) is blank
