

## Denver Fire Department Permits for Events Within the Colorado Convention Center and Bellco Theater

Show Management or their designated contractor is responsible for submitting the required information and floorplans directly to Denver Fire. Directions for submitting information to Denver's Permitting and Licensing system are attached.

## **Floorplans**

Event floor plans for all contracted space (Exhibit Hall(s), Ballroom(s), Meeting Room(s), and Lobby Space) should be submitted to both DFD and the CCC a minimum of **two weeks** prior to the first move in day.

Current DFD Fee for Floorplan Approvals: \$75 per event (subject to change)

The CCC can assist in reviewing plans for code compliance when provided floorplans prior to submission to DFD. The CCC **cannot** approve floor plans or issue/track permit status on behalf of DFD.

CCC Management reserves the right to require changes to floor plans either before, during or after approval by Denver Fire Prevention.

# Tents, Canopies, Multi-Story, Covered/Enclosed Booths

All the above should be labeled on floor plan submissions. Size and setup will determine capacity, egress and smoke detector/fire extinguisher requirements.

Multi-Story and Covered/Enclosed Booths have additional information requirements by both the CCC and DFD. Ask your Event Manager for more information.

# **Fueled Vehicles/Equipment**

All fueled vehicles being displayed in the building must be labeled on the floorplan submission and noted in the application. Electric Vehicles have special requirements. Ask your Event Manager for details.

These include cars, trucks, semi-trucks, RV's, construction/farm equipment, food trucks, lawn equipment, boats, etc. All fueled vehicles must follow the requirements which include: no more than ¼ tank or 5 gallons of fuel (whichever is less), battery is disconnected, fuel cap is secured/taped closed, and flooring is protected.

#### **Open Flame**

This covers candles, sterno and/or the use of propane for cooking or heating and should be listed on floor plan submissions. Propane bottles on the show floor are limited to one-pound bottles and the total number are limited.

## **Pyrotechnics & Cryogenics**

Both DFD and the CCC must be provided with product information and layout during the application process.

#### Haze/Fog

Haze does not need to be permitted as the CCC holds the annual permit. A Haze Request must be submitted along with fluid Safety Data Sheet (SDS) and all haze/fog times.

Current CCC Haze Use Fee: \$150 per hour (subject to change)

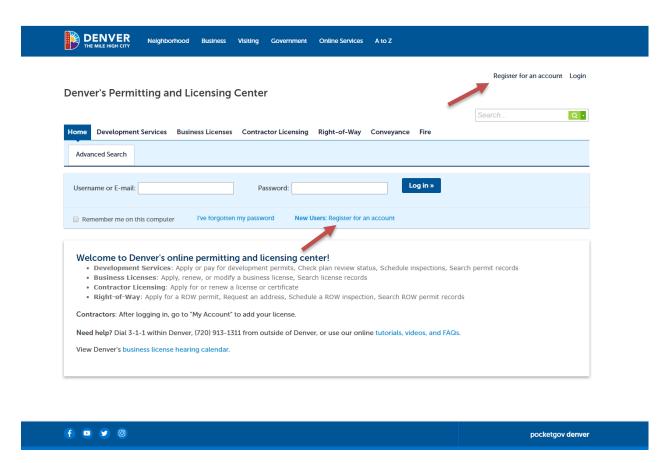

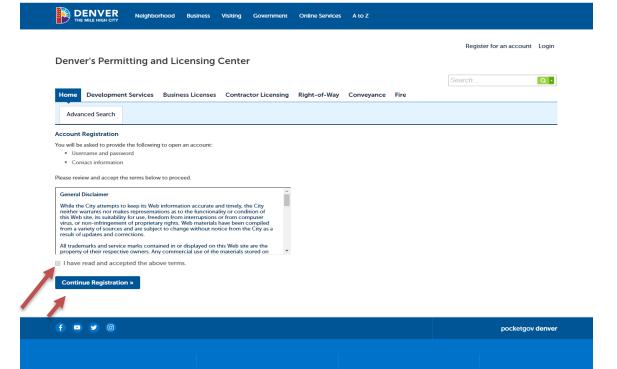
## Welcome to Denver's ePermit System - Accela Citizen Access

Denver's e-permit system, Accela Citizen Access, is the public user's means of submitting applications and tracking their progess as well as monitoring permit activity and renewals. In order for a public user to access e-permits, they must first register for an account. This section will demonstrate the following registration steps:

- 1. To access ACA, navigate to the following web URL City and County of Denver | ePermit online
- 2. On the home page, click on either of the registration links.

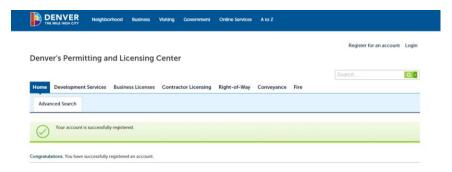


3. This opens the general disclaimer, after reading and acknowledging, select Continue Registration.



4. This opens the account creation form. Fill in the required fields for account creation. 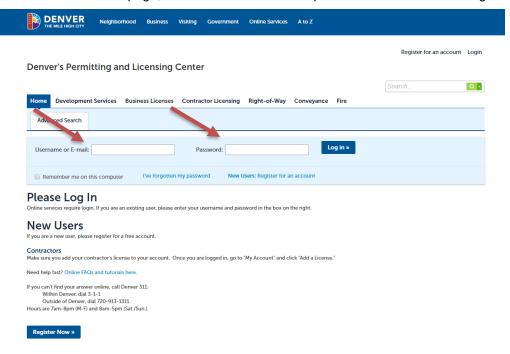
Once you have completed the account registration you will see a message that your account is successfully registered.



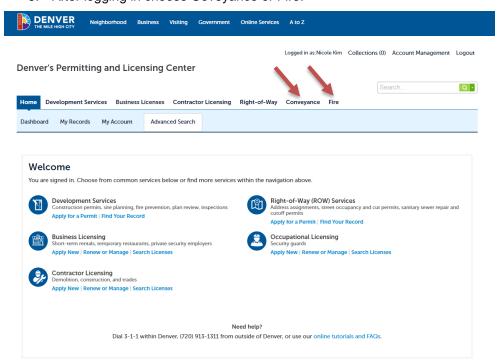
## Logging in to the Account

1. After completing the registration steps, navigate again to the home page in order to log in: City and County of Denver | ePermit online

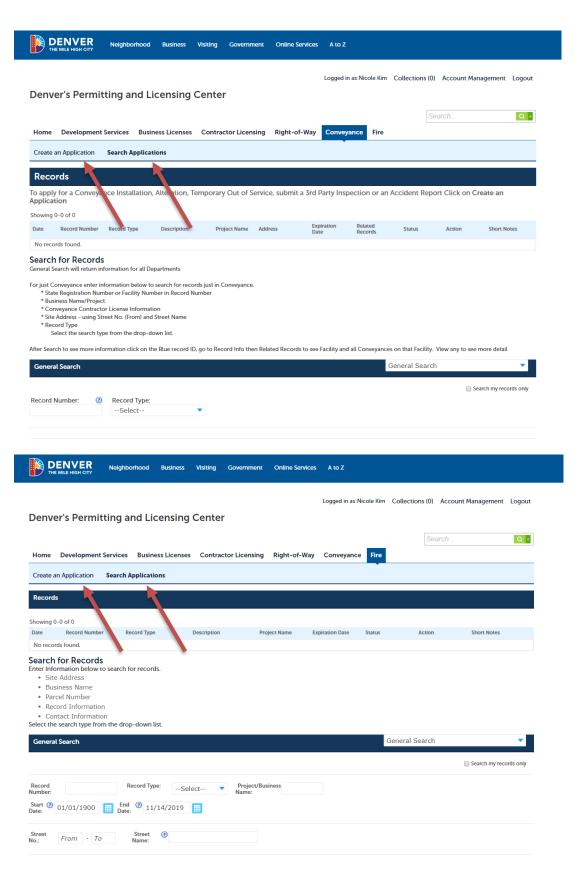
2. On the home page, enter the user name and password. Then click on Login.



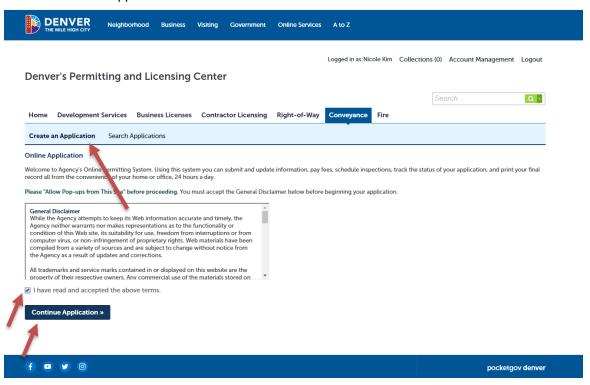
3. After logging in choose Coveyance or Fire.



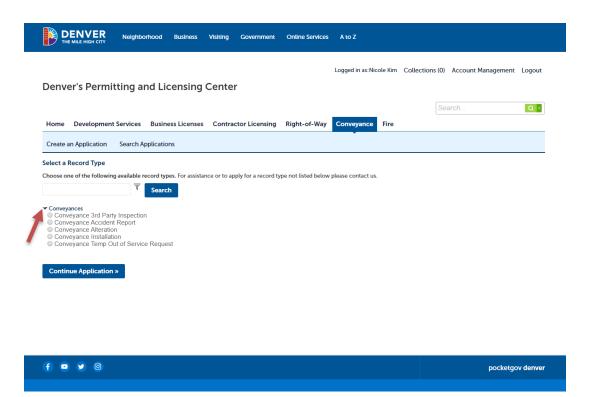
4. Under Conveyance or Fire you may Search Applications which are already associated with your Account, or Create an Application.

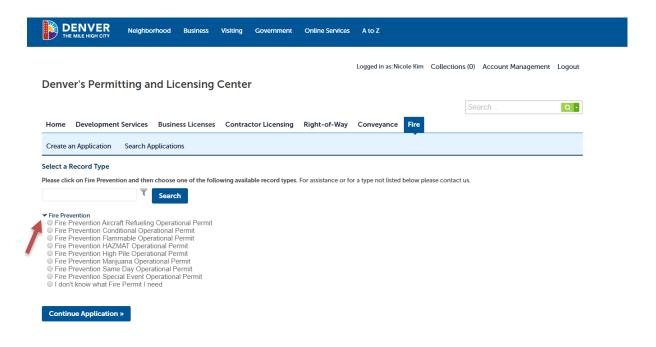


5. To Create an Application, click on Create an Application and accept the Disclaimer, then click to Continue Application.



Click the arrow to the left of Conveyances or Fire Prevention to expand the list of Application options.

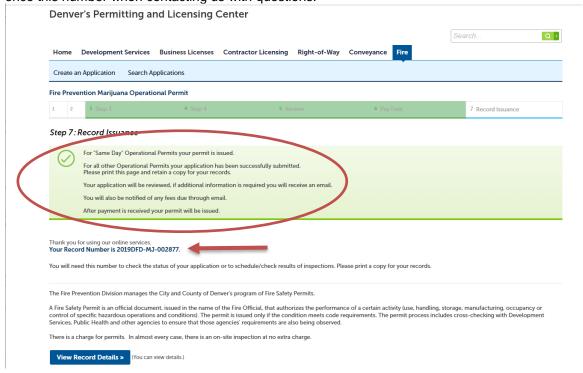




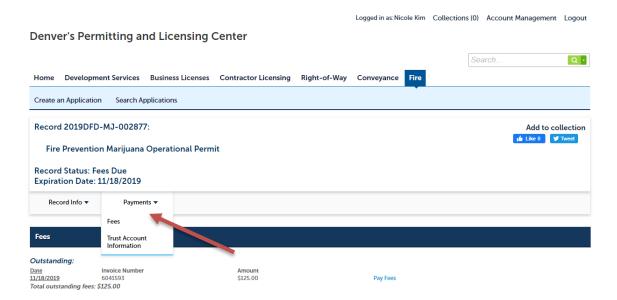


- 7. After selecting the Application type you will fill in the relevant information in order to submit the application. Once you have entered all of the information, click on Continue Application. You will have an opportunity to review the application and all information sections before submitting the application. Once the application is completed, you will choose to Submit the Application.

- 10. For all applications, except Same Day, once you have submitted your application it will be reviewed and you will be notified via email of status changes, additional documentation required,

and fees due. You will receive a Record Number once the application is submitted, please reference this number when contacting us with questions.



- 11. Once the application has been reviewed and fees are due, you will be notified via email to pay fees. You may pay fees online through the link received via email, or by choosing the Record and selecting the Payments tab and through the ePermit system. You may also pay fees in person at 745 W Colfax Avenue, or by mail: P.O. Box 733422, Dallas, TX 75373-3422
- 12. Once fees have been paid and the permit is ready to issue a copy will be sent to you via email. This copy must be posted on site.
