Please note – new – for the 2022 event: As of mid-December, California state mandate requires all exhibitors and attendees to wear facial masks. Proof of vaccination status OR proof of a negative COVID test is required and will be verified with a form of identification. Pre-entry testing must be performed, within 24 hours for Antigen test or 48 hours PCR test, prior to entering the event. Please plan accordingly.
