Natural Products Expo Exhibitor Donation Form

Natural Products Expo West, in conjunction with the Anaheim Convention Center and GES, will be coordinating donation services at NPEW 2022.

Why Donate?

By donating your extra exhibit material we can work together to prevent goods from going to waste or entering landfills as well as have a positive impact on the Anaheim community. Goods donated will be picked up by various local non-profit organizations.

Guidelines:

Packing: To ensure that all donation-collection companies are able to transport the contributed goods, all items must be packaged and ready for pick up before you leave the building on final show day. All items must be labeled using the donation stickers provided.

Labels: "Donation" stickers are available at the GES Service Center on-site. All items left on the exhibit hall floor must be clearly labeled.

Labor: If you require labor to package your donated goods, please complete the Labor Order Form and submit to GES.

Materials: Please ensure all donated items are in good condition. Any damaged or incomplete items will be disposed of at the exhibitor's expense.

The items being collected for donation include, but are not limited to:

Habitat for Humanity

Building Materials	Roofing Materials	Hard Flooring
Carpet Rolls/Carpet Tiles	Fabric	Furniture
Lumber	Glass	Empty Boxes/Crates
Office Supplies	Decor and Accessories	

The following items will not be collected for donation:

- Partial items (example: a portion of a flooring display)
- Marketing materials and/or brochures (these will be recycled if possible)
- Damaged or cracked materials

Food Product Donations

Natural Products Expo West will also be accepting food and other products for donations to Second Harvest (Local Non-profit). If you would like to donate non-refrigerated, refrigerated, or freezer products, simply pick up a sticker from your GES Service Center or Informa Floor Manager. A form is NOT necessary for donation of these products.
