

# Booth Regulations

## Inline Booth

- 10' wide / 10' deep
- 8' height (back wall)

## Corner Booth

- A corner booth is a linear booth at the end of a series of in-line booths with exposure to intersecting aisles on two sides. All guidelines for linear booths apply.
- 10' wide / 10' deep
- 8' height (back wall)

## Perimeter Booth

- A perimeter booth is a linear booth that backs to an outside wall of the exhibit facility rather than to another exhibit.
- 10' wide / 10' deep
- Up to 12' height (back wall)

## End Cap Booth

- A linear booth positioned as a peninsula or split island
- 20' wide / 10' deep
- 10' max backwall width
- 5' height on the two side aisles / display height is 4'
- 8' height (back wall)

## Peninsula Booth

- A peninsula booth is exposed to 3 sides, usually 20 x 20
- Height allowance 16' -20'
- Double sided signs, logos and graphics shall be set back 10' from adjacent booths

## Island Booth

- An island booth is any size booth exposed to aisles on all four sides
- Typical size is 20 x 20
- Height allowance 16' – 20'

## Hanging Signs

- Approval for the use of hanging signs and graphics, at any height, should be received from the organizer at least 60 days prior to installation. Variances may be issued at the organizer's discretion. Drawings should be available for inspection.
