

## Certificate of Insurance Instructions (COI)

As a reminder, APA requires that all exhibitors, at their sole cost and expense, procure and maintain throughout the Annual Meeting (including move-in and move-out days):

- (1) comprehensive general liability insurance with limits of not less than **\$3,000,000** each occurrence, combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage, including coverage for personal injury, contractual, operation of mobile equipment, products and completed operations;
- (2) worker's compensation coverage; and
- (3) comprehensive motor vehicle liability of not less than **\$1,000,000** per occurrence

covering all of the exhibitor's activities and representatives engaged in the performance of any work for the exhibitor.

The commercial general and automobile liability insurance policies must name as additional insureds *the American Psychiatric Association; Global Experience Specialists, Inc. (GES); City and County of San Francisco; SMG; ASM Global Parent, Inc.; the Moscone Center Joint Venture; the Trustees of the Moscone Center Project; and all directors, members, officers, agents, employees, affiliates, and subsidiaries of each of the above.*

A certificate of insurance showing the required coverage must be provided to APA.
