Before any Contractors or Vendors load in for the show, please be aware of and inform all your onsite managers and foremen about the building policy, which applies to all BOH workers, clients, and guests who may be exposed to a hazardous area.

- Team San Jose has determined that the loading dock and all areas where forklifts operate are hazardous. PPE is required for all persons that may be exposed to the hazard.
- Team San Jose has determined all areas under or near overhead work are hazardous. PPE is required for all persons that may be exposed to the hazard.
- Your companies must supply PPE to your employees.
- If you have contractors, they or you supply PPE to work in these areas on TSJ buildings.
- TSJ will supply PPE to IATSE 134 if needed; they are TSJ employees.
- All this and the ID requirements are in the Team San Jose Access Control System.
- ACS is a TSJ building policy.
- TSJ ACS complies with OSHA subpart 1910 (a-h) regarding PPE.
- PPE and ID requirements are on pages 2 and 3.
- All visiting workers must enter and exit by the employee entrance on Viola Street (see maps below). Pedestrian traffic is prohibited on the loading dock ramp.
- Please provide the names of all visiting managers and foremen for easy communication throughout the event.
