





CO-LOCATING EXHIBITOR POLICY & PROCEDURES

Per the rules governing Expo! Expo! San Antonio, Texas...

An exhibitor shall not assign, sell its rights, sublet, share or apportion the whole or any part of the space allotted, or have representatives, products, equipment, signs, or printed materials from others than its own company in the said exhibit space without the written consent of IAEE. Sharing of any exhibit space is permitted only by a CVB and one publicly-owned facility (i.e. event center).

This policy is strictly enforced by Show Management.

All publicly-owned facilities planning to share space/co-locate with their CVBs must receive approval from IAEE. Once approved, each facility must submit a separate, signed Expo! Expo! contract to IAEE. There is no charge from IAEE for participation as a co-locating exhibitor, however, the signed contract must be received by IAEE prior to the show in order to participate.
