

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: TEXAS SALES TAX COMPLIANCE

Executive Summary

This notice is relevant to exhibitors that anticipate making sales at the NRA Annual Meetings and Exhibits. This notice may not apply to “display-only” exhibitors. This notice is provided to exhibitors as a reminder of the high profile of the NRA Annual Meetings and Exhibits. Please continue to keep in mind that compliance with tax regulations is required. Representatives of the tax authorities, as well as media, typically attend the NRA Annual Meetings and Exhibits.

Tax Information

Texas statutes generally require that a business or person making retail sales in Texas must register, collect, and pay sales tax to the Texas Comptroller’s Office.
