## Gaylord Opryland Resort & Convention Center Exhibitor / Vendor F&B Distribution Provisions

Gaylord Opryland Resort & Convention Center is pleased to allow exhibitors and vendors for NAMA/IBWA to distribute food and beverage products under the following provisions:

- The product being served must be a marketed product of the exhibitors / vendors (Example: Coca Cola can serve samples of their beverages only). Exhibitors / vendors may not distribute other companies' products; these items must be ordered through Gaylord Opryland's catering department.
- The product is served only in the exhibit hall and at the appropriate booth.
- The product is considered a sample portion. A sample portion is defined as two ounces or less of food and three ounces or less of beverage.
- The designated drayage company for NAMA/IBWA will be responsible for the storage of the product.
- The product served is non-alcoholic and will not interfere or impede the legal and procedural agreement between the hotel and the Tennessee Alcohol and Beverage Commission.
- Exhibitors with NAMA/IBWA and their agents, officers, directors or employees will be responsible for the order, delivery, set-up, storage, removal and dispensing of the product and it's packaging.
