Move-In Options for Personally Owned Vehicles:

Personally Owned Vehicle (POV)

What is a Personally Owned Vehicle? A POV, or personally owned vehicle, is considered to be any vehicle that is primarily designed to transport passengers, not cargo or freight. Please note that these vehicles cannot have any branding and/or company logos on them to be considered a POV.

Examples of POVs: Passenger vehicles under 1 ton: Small pickup trucks, passenger vans, taxis, limos, Uber, Lyft, Cars, etc.

What is not a POV: Company Vehicles of any kind, trailers, moving vans, U-Hauls, Cargo Vans, vehicle with a lift gate, materials on skids/pallets, crates, anything requiring freight moving equipment.



<u>Cartload Service:</u> (250lbs. max.) GES can help you unload your passenger vehicle. Ordering Cartload Service is available under the Hand Carry/Cartload & Personally Owned Vehicles.

Cartload Service to Move-In & Move-Out

To Use Cartload Service

- Must have 2 people ages 18 and over
- Must have "loose" product (not palletized/crated)
- Total weight of items must be <u>less than 250lbs</u>. (Cartloads and POV that exceed 250lbs will be charged at standard Material Handing rates.)
- Vehicle must be "acceptable" as shown above

If ALL items above apply, you may use Cartload Service! Proceed to the Marshalling Yard.

- GES can help unload a passenger vehicle. Pre-order Cartload Service by Calling us at 1-800-475-2089.
- Move-In may happen at/or after the targeted Installation Start Time & Date.
- All Cartload and POV customers MUST go to the GES Marshaling Yard to check in FIRST.

- Look for "Cartload Service Personally Owned Vehicles (POV) ONLY" signs to check in for POV/Cartload.
- Check in with a GES Representative to obtain a dock pass and directions on where to be unloaded.
- Vehicles for Cartload Service will be unloaded first come, first served as dock space is available.
- GES will direct the vehicle toward the cartload area for unloading.
- Cars may not be left unattended at any time. There must be two (2) people with the vehicle; one person to go with the product to the booth space and one person to remove the vehicle from the dock.
- Cartload service has a **45-minute** max time to unload. Personally Owned Vehicles that are left unattended will be towed away at the exhibitor's expense.

<u>Self Unload</u>: (250 lbs. max.) An exhibitor can <u>Self Unload</u> your own materials to your booth, provided you <u>do not</u> use material handling equipment to assist you and you are moving 250 lbs max of freight. Use of any four-wheel cart or dolly is <u>prohibited</u>. Use of <u>two-wheel</u> hand trucks will be permitted. You will not be permitted access to the loading dock or freight areas.

- Cars may not be left unattended at any time. There must be two (2) people with the vehicle; one
 person to go with the product to the booth space and one person to remove the vehicle. Items
 unloaded via Uber and Lyft share rides curb side <u>cannot</u> be left unattended. GES and the GWCC have
 designated areas and any unattended vehicles will be towed away at the exhibitor's expense.
- Personally Owned Vehicle must be performed by a full-time employee of the exhibiting company and could be asked by the Union for proof of employment (paystub/benefits documentation).
- The use of hand trucks, pallet jacks, lift gates or any other mechanical equipment is **NOT** permitted by anyone other than GES employees.
- Move-in for self unloaders may happen at/or after the targeted Installation Start Time & Date but no earlier.
- POV's needing GES assistance must arrive on their targeted date and time.
- More detailed Targeted Move-In and Move-Out instructions can be found on our website.
- Show Site Work Rules/Union Jurisdiction Regulations must be abided by.

*Please note that the Georgia World Congress Center is a State Facility and Members of the Union claim jurisdiction on the operation of all material handling equipment, all unloading and reloading, and handling of empty containers. An exhibitor may ONLY move materials that can be carried by hand, by one person in one trip, without the use of dollies, hand trucks, or other mechanical equipment.
