

Sampling Policy & Handwashing Station

Your organization IS NOT required to file a temporary food permit, but inspectors will be present over the dates of the tradeshow to ensure that your company's booth follows the Orange County Health District regulations. The health department reserves the right to shut down individual booths that are not in compliance with the regulations.

Those companies serving food and beverage samples are required to complete a Sampling Authorization Form and have a temporary handwashing station, photo is below.

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If your company is sampling a pre-packaged item, you are not required to have a temporary handwashing station. But once you open that item (divide into parts to give as a food sample), you are required to have a handwashing station.

Food Samples

The sample-size requirements at the Orange County Convention Center for ANC22 are:

- ➤ Six (6 oz.) for food
- > Eight (8 oz.) beverages
