DISPOSAL OF HAZARDOUS/MEDICAL WASTE ENA 2014 Annual Conference October 9 – 11, 2014

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT THIS FORM TO ENA EXHIBIT SERVICES BY SEPTEMBER 8, 2014

Hazardous waste is any material being stored, recycled or thrown away that could cause injury or death, or pollute air, land, or water.

Definitions:

- Regulated Medical Waste can include liquid or semi-liquid blood or other potentially infectious materials; contaminated items that would release blood or other potentially infectious materials in a liquid or semi-liquid state if compressed; items that are caked with dried blood or other potentially infectious materials and are capable of releasing these materials during handling; contaminated sharps; and pathological and microbiological wastes containing blood or other potentially infectious materials.
- "Sharps" can be defined as any discarded article that may cause punctures or cuts. Such waste includes, but is not limited to, items such as needles, IV tubing and syringes with needles attached, and scalpel blades.
- Exhibitors who generate material fitting any of these criteria, during the course of their meeting activities should:
- Be aware of the full scope of the hazard(s) associated with their waste(s).
- Conform to the requirements of all regulatory agencies having jurisdiction in the location of the creation of hazardous waste.
- Ensure that all personnel who could possibly be engaged in the transportation, containerization, use, coordination, or disposal are fully informed of associated risks.
- Inform ENA, by using the enclosed form, of the presence and planned disposition of hazardous waste to allow for thorough planning and preparation and to preclude any misunderstanding. PLEASE NOTE: All exhibitors must complete the Disposal of Hazardous Waste Form and return it to ENA by September 8, 2014.
