VEHICLE DISPLAYS

Important Rules and Regulations

The WEWCC and City Fire Marshal requires the following guidelines are in place for vehicle displays:

- Battery cables must be disconnected
- Protective covering under the vehicle
- Gas tank may not contain no more than 5 gallons or (1/4) tank of fuel, whichever is less
- Gas tank must either be taped shut or have a lockable gas cap

For many of the vehicles 5 gallons is less than 1/4 tank, so please keep this in mind as this will be checked at the marshalling yard and vehicles will not be allowed to proceed to the convention center unless they are compliant. If the vehicle needs to have more gas in it for the move to convention center and start and removal from the convention center, then a detailed explanation of what fuel is needed will need to be provided for fire marshal waiver.

Each exhibitor is responsible for checking local Fire Marshal rules and regulations for additional requirements.

Please refer to the Mobile Display Units/ Heavy Equipment & Direct Machinery section of the service kit for Vehicle move-in dates.

You are required to supervise your vehicle placement.

GES charges a round-trip fee, per vehicle, to place a vehicle on the trade show floor.

If you will be displaying a vehicle at the show, you are required to complete the Display Vehicle & Oversized Equipment Request Form located in Mobile Display Units/ Heavy Equipment & Direct Machinery section of the service kit.
